1. The Government of Mongolia has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) under Loan 3679-MON toward the cost of the **Regional Road Development and Maintenance Project (Phase 1)** and has applied for Additional Financing from ADB to implement Phase 2 of the same project. Part of the proceeds of these loans will be used for payments under the Package named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
2. The **Ministry of Road and Transport Development of Mongolia** (“the Employer”) invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for **the construction and completion of Package ZTHYa/201902104: Reconstruction of Route Ulaanbaatar-Darkhan Road**, which comprises the following contracts (“the Works”):
 - Contract CW 1-1: 37.26 km road section from departing west province roundabout to north of Khar modot pass, reconstruction of 37.26 km roads with bridges, pipe, culvers, earth works, and pavement.
 - Contract CW 1-2: 45.5 km road section from North of Khar modot pass to Urikhan, reconstruction of 45.5 km roads with bridges, pipe, culvers, earth works, and pavement.
 - Contract CW 1-3: 45.74 km road section from Urikhan to Sumber intersection, reconstruction of 45.74 km roads with bridges, pipe, culvers, earth works, and pavement.
 - Contract CW 1-4: 45.08 km road section from Sumber intersection to Tsaidam valley, reconstruction of 45.08 km roads with bridges, pipe, culvers, earth works, and pavement.
 - Contract CW 1-5: 30.53 km road section from Tsaidam valley to Darkhan roundabout, reconstruction of 30.53 km roads with bridges, pipe, culvers, earth works, and pavement.

Bidders may bid for one, more than one, or all contracts.

3. **International Competitive Bidding (ICB)** will be conducted in accordance with ADB’s [Single-Stage: One-Envelope](#) bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Documents.

4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in the bidding:

6. To purchase the Bidding Documents in the English, eligible Bidders should:

- Write to the address above requesting for Bidding Documents for Package ZTHYa/201902104: Reconstruction of Route Ulaanbaatar-Darkhan road indicating which Contracts they are interested in.
